

# The Barinski



## Materials:

- **Hook:** Standard dry fly #12 - #20
- **Thread:** 6/0 Fluorescent green
- **Body:** Fluorescent green wire
- **Collar:** White Ostrich Herl
- **Head:** Peacock Herl

## Directions:

1. Tie in thread about  $\frac{1}{4}$  back from the eye and wind back to just past the barb.
2. Tie in green wire and bind down forming a thin tapered body with the thread leaving the thread at the tie in point.
3. Wrap the wire forward evenly up to the tie in point and secure with the thread and cut off the tag of the wire. Bind that down and work the thread back to a little back of the tie in point.
4. Tie in the ostrich herl by the tip and form the collar with 3 or 4 wraps and tie down. Clip and bind down the butts.
5. Tie in the peacock by the tip and form the head with 3 or 4 wraps then bind it down.
6. Clip the butts and whip finish a compact head.
7. Add head cement and you are done.
