

# SHARK'S CADDIS LARVA

## Materials

**Hook:** Curved small caddis Type

**Thread:** Black

**Head:** Gold bead

**Body:** Yellow antron yarn and hare's dubbing

**Thorax:** Two peacock herls

Step 1: Place bead on hook, and run thread behind bead. Build up thread so bead stays in place.

Step 2: Run thread to bend of hook, and tie in antron, and split the antron into two sections, with one section being larger than other.

Step 3: Wrap larger section of antron up shaft of hook to a spot just behind the bead. Leave enough room for herl to be tied in.

Step 4: Wrap thread in even spaces over the antron, and tie in at the head.

Step 5: Dub the remainder of the antron with dubbing, and wrap body of fly to the head. Tie off.

Step 6: Tie in herl, and make two wraps behind the bead, tie off.



We would like to thank Deloris for this months fly. It was really easy to tie. Deloris says she found this fly to be very useful and that you shouldn't be without this Shark Caddis Larva when you start you nymph fishing.
